CORONAVIRUS SAEFTY & PREVENTION

Here are a few <u>Coronavirus safety and prevention tips</u> Georgia Heritage Federal Credit Union is using.

1. Hand Washing & Sanitizing - All employees are washing their hands frequently. In fact, it's estimated that frequent, proper handwashing could slow the spread of COVID-19 significantly.

2. Keep ATMs, Money Receptacles and Other Surfaces Clean - We already keep our ATMs and money receptacles clean, but we are doing a little extra to sanitize touchpoints and keep them safe for members and non-member customers! Furthermore, any frequently touched items, objects, and surfaces get the same treatment. This includes desks, counters, pens, and door handles.

3. Remote Work - Not all employees need to be on premise to do their jobs effectively. Many staff who aren't member-facing are working remotely occasionally. Minimizing employee contact will greatly reduce their chance of getting infected.

4. Closing Branch Lobbies - We have found alternative ways to serve our members through drive-through banking, ATMs, by appointment and online and mobile banking.

5. Social Distancing - We are practicing social distancing within the branches. The World Health Organization states that it is an important and effective way to slow the spread of COVID-19.

6. Stay Informed - We continue to monitor the World Health Organization (WHO), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) websites as well as local and federal news for current updates.

Smart ways to spend your tax refund

A tax refund is a great chance to better your financial footing. If you're expecting a refund this year, consider these 10 ways to use the money wisely.

- **1. Start an emergency fund** Aim to set aside 3-6 months' worth of must-pay living expenses.
- **2. Further your career** Invest in yourself by funding additional job training, tuition, a work-related conference or membership in a professional organization that can enhance your future paychecks, job stability and career potential.
- **3. Pay off debt** Start paying those debts with the highest interest rates; eliminating these will save you the most money in the long run.
- **4. Put it into an IRA** Even if you have a 401(k) through your employer, you can open your own individual retirement account to supplement that plan.
- **5. Start (or add to) a college fund for your kids** College tuition is only going up. You can't start saving for your little ones' futures early enough.

6. Invest - Whether real estate, stocks or another type of investment, sock your funds into an account that will help it grow!

7. Home ownership - If you're saving for a home, use your refund to increase your down payment to avoid costly private mortgage insurance and reduce the amount of your mortgage. If you've already got a mortgage, make an extra payment or two to reduce the principal.

8. Make home improvements - Make your home more functional while increasing its resale value by tackling those needed home repair and improvement projects.

9. Buy life insurance - A term life policy can provide protection for loved ones at a relatively low cost. For the cost of a few hundred dollars, your tax refund can allow your family to maintain its standard of living if the unthinkable happens.
